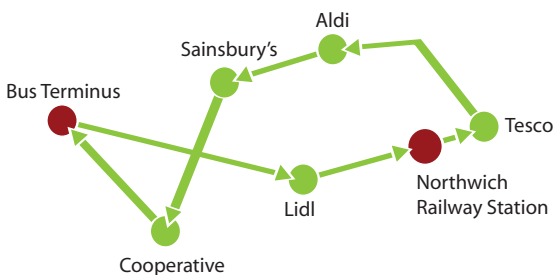
Service Details:

The 'Northwich Nipper' is a FREE BUS SERVICE that will commence a trial service on Monday 20th September for a period of six weeks providing FREE transport for rail travellers, shoppers, workers and visitors to Northwich.

The bus will run from Monday - Friday connecting the Railway Station with the Bus Terminus with stops at the major supermarkets - Tesco, Aldi, Sainsbury's, Cooperative (Somerfield) and Lidl.

The Route:

Northwich Rail Station - Tesco - Aldi - Sainsbury's - Cooperative (Somerfield) - Bus Terminus - Lidl - Railway Station.



*Timetable:

First Departure	- Northwich Railway Station:	08.35 & 35 mins past the hour each hour
First Arrival/Departure	- Northwich Bus Terminus:	08.50 & 50 mins past the hour each hour
First Arrival	- Northwich Railway Station:	09.00 & 00 mins past the hour each hour
Last Departure	- Northwich Railway Station:	15.35
Last Departure	- Northwich Bus Terminus:	15.50
Last Arrival	- Northwich Railway Station:	16.00

Between these times the service will operate approximately every 30 minutes providing connections to train services to and from Chester & Manchester. *Timings are approximate.
