## Station to Station relay walk

The Stockton & Darlington Railway opened on 27 September 1825, connecting places, people, communities and ideas and ultimately transforming the world.

Railway 200 is a year-long nationwide partnership-led campaign to celebrate 200 years of the modern railway and inspire a new generation of young pioneering talent to choose a career in rail. It invites community, rail and other groups to get involved.

The Mid Cheshire Community Rail Partnership is marking the anniversary with a 'baton relay'.

Over six days in September, walkers will carry a special baton, created by Northwich Toppers, along the historic Cheshire Lines Committee route from Manchester to Chester.
